Homecoming Parade Guidelines

- 1. Sign up deadline for the parade by Thursday, September 14.
- 2. All participants in the parade operating any motor vehicle must have a valid motor vehicle license and proof of insurance with them at all times.
- 3. No candy can be thrown from motor vehicles and floats. Candy can be distributed by persons walking along the parade routes. This is to prevent a reoccurrence of incidents that have happened in the past.
- 4. Each motor vehicle will be approximately 3 car lengths away from other entries in the parade.
- 5. Be aware that in the event of a fire or police emergency, the parade line may have to break up to allow passage of the emergency equipment.
- 6. Drawbars & Safety Chains: When one vehicle is towing or pulling another vehicle, the drawbar or other connection shall be sufficient strength to pull all weight towed thereby and shall be fastened to the frame of the towing vehicle in such a manner as to prevent sideways movement. In addition to these connections, there shall be a safety chain which shall be fastened so as to be capable of holding the towed vehicle should the principle connection for some reason fail.
- 7. If there are any questions at the staging area, bring them to the attention of the parade committee.

Float Line-Up:

All High School athletes, class floats, and band members will line up in front of the Atlantic Middle School along 11th St. and Linn St.

Middle School students will line up under the catwalk between the middle school and Schuler buildings.

All other high school students, participating parents and general public will line up on Linn Street street heading South and into the Zion Lutheran Church parking lot in the order they arrive.

The parade begins at 2:30 pm.
